### ENTRY SHOW INFORMATION

In order to make the entry process for our schooling shows as painless as possible, please adhere to the following:

#### ENTRIES

1. Fill out an Oxbow/ESDCTA/OCDA entry form. Include legible e-mail for times and be sure to include a phone number where you can be reached.
2. Fill out the classes or divisions you are entering.
3. Include a check made out to Oxbow Stables, Inc. to cover entry fees and stabling fees. Credit cards accepted. You can keep credit card on file.
4. Post Entries: Anything **received** after the closing date will be subject to a late fee of \$20
4. Include a current (within 12 months of the show) negative coggins test. We will keep your coggins on file so you don't have to re-submit one.
6. **Refunds** before Closing Date. **Credit** toward another show after Closing Date.
7. Any dressage test may be ridden as a "Fix A Test". Ride same test twice with coaching by the judge between rides. Fee \$55
8. Clear Round Jumping: 1st round: \$20 - Additional rounds: \$5  
 Scheduled at the end of each division. Please pre-register.

9. Lost Pinney Fee: \$30
10. Management reserves the right to cancel, combine or add classes and/or judges if entries warrant.
11. Hard hats **must be worn** when mounted.
12. Please, No Dogs.
13. Food Concession on Grounds

**AWARDS:** Awards and 6 -10 ribbons per class. Special awards include "Dressage High Score", "Eventing Low Score" and "Closest to Optimum Time". Division Championships awarded in Equitation and " and "Jump for the Cure" (min of 3 entries).
